

The Formentera Council Offices of Tourism and Environment wish to report that February 22 is the final day to request funding under the Save Posidonia Project. Projects proposed must be related to conservation of posidonia seagrass.

Applicants may represent companies or individuals, and the initiatives they propose must be based on posidonia protection.

Applications should be submitted digitally at the Citizen's Information Office, whether in person at the office's brick-and-mortar location (OAC) or online at the OVAC. After the deadline, proposals will be evaluated by a technical panel of experts from the international, national and local spheres with the help of well-known NGOs. Submissions will be appraised within 20 days and winners will be announced on the Council's bulletin board.
