



This morning, Ana Juan, president of the Consell de Formentera, opened Environment Days (*Jornades de Medi Ambient*), a conference organised by the University of the Balearic Islands and the Natural History Society of the Balearics that will run through tomorrow at Centre Antoni Tur "Gabrielet".
