



Consell de Formentera president Alejandra Ferrer and the entire governing team invited the administration workforce to join them in celebrating a holiday tradition by raising their glasses for a Christmas toast. Ferrer called it “an extra special moment”, noting the Yuletide reception was her first since taking office as president.
