

Tuesday, April 28, from 8pm in the exhibition hall of the ajuntament vell, there will be an showing of the winning photographs and a selection of works by the participants of the 13th edition of the Beni Trutmann photography contest. This year 37 people participated with 80 photographs showing landscapes, nature and culture of the island.

Beni Trutmann was a great photographer who was born in Locarno (Switzerland) in 1935, and died an 28 April 2002 in Formentera. The date of awards and exhibition of photographs that the jury deems best will coincide, as every year, with the date of his death. Trutmann discovered Formentera 1958, and over 44 years photographed the island, leaving behind a legacy of over 30,000 photographs.
