



Last night, the illustrator Tres Voltes Rebel, a.k.a. Ame Soler, pulled back the curtain on *Som les bruixes d'avui*, an exhibition which has brought to the island by Formentera's culture department as part of celebrations surrounding International Day for the Elimination of Violence against Women. Born in Valencia and based in Barcelona, the artist creates illustrations advocating women and men's equality.
