

A group of individuals receiving care at the Formentera Day Centre donned T-shirts emblazoned with the message 'Don't drown in alcohol' to help drive home the importance of preventing alcohol consumption among underage islanders. The push is backed by the Formentera Office of Social Welfare and aims to delay the start of alcohol consumption among islanders, or prevent it outright, as well as combat the illegal sale of alcoholic beverages. 'Don't drown in alcohol' launched last May and will continue this winter with new awareness-building actions.
