

10 newly arrived islanders complete Course in Social and Cultural Integration

Yesterday ten students from a range of backgrounds including Colombia, Argentina, Morocco and Brazil completed a course offered by the Formentera Office of Social Welfare to promote social and cultural integration. 2021 marks the fifteenth year of the Curs d'Integració Social i Cultural. Rafael Ramírez, Councillor of Social Welfare, attended the last class and presented students with diplomas. The councillor applauded the "interest and resolve of participants", for whom the course offers the prospect of an integration report from the Balearic Islands' regional government and preparation for the CCSE citizenship test.

Classes at the Escola d'Adults were given by Dolores Fernández Tamargo and focused on the constitutional values of the Spanish state, human rights and public freedoms, the Balearic Statute of Autonomy, the European Union and equality between women and men.
