



Answering a call from the Spanish Federation of Municipalities and Provinces that was launched at the behest of the Spanish ministry of the interior and the Association of Victims of Terrorism, the Formentera Council has opted to join the movement to observe a moment of silence at 11.00am today, March 11 (a day abbreviated as “11-M”). The gathering will be held on the steps of the Council in plaça de la Constitució in memory of the victims of the terrorist attacks which took place fifteen years ago today, on March 11, 2004. The day is also recognised in Europe as Day of Remembrance of Victims of Terrorism. CiF president Jaume Ferrer was joined by cabinet and opposition councillors as well as administration staff in taking part in the event.
